The City of Niles is seeking an individual to perform day-to-day maintenance, troubleshooting, inspection, and testing of the power and control for our Electric and Water systems. These systems include: electrical substations, voltage regulation, distribution system protection, backup power systems, transmission switching stations, water tower control systems, water well control systems, water filtration control systems, power switch gear, heating and ventilation systems, PLC controllers, relaying, monitoring, security control systems, sprinkling systems, 1 and 3 phase wiring and repair of buildings, control panels, and metering systems. Input and maintain outage information. May require general duties commensurate with Master Electrician License and assisting other field crews.

Possession and maintenance of a Michigan Master Electrician’s license or a Michigan Journeyman Line Work license, or three years of electrical apprentice training or equivalent.

Must possess a CDL-B and be able to obtain a CDL-A within 6 months of employment.
