Effective on and after September 1, 2011

**RATE 2+25 and 2R+25: GENERAL SERVICE - CITY AND NON-CITY
AVAILABILITY**

Available to general service customers using electric energy measured at a single point by one meter whose average usage exceeds **25 kW**.

Voltage: Primary: Approximately 2,400 v - 27,600v
Secondary: Approximately 480v, 240v, or 240/120v.

Phase: Single or Three Cycles: 60

RATE PER METER PER MONTH

MINIMUM CHARGE

The above rate is subject to a minimum monthly charge equal to 25 kW times the capacity charge of \$13.10/kW (\$327.50) (Rate: 2101)

DELAYED PAYMENT CHARGE

The above rate is net if paid in full on or before the due date of the bill. On all accounts not so paid, an additional charge of five (5) per cent of the total amount billed (but not less than ten cents) will be made.

FUEL CLAUSE

For each kwhr. sold under this rate, the customer will be credited or charged at the same rate that the City is credited or charged by the Indiana and Michigan Electric Company, based upon the “MRS” rate as filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission on August 9, 1984 as amended by the correction of an error and through negotiations.

MEASUREMENT OF ENERGY AND DETERMINATION OF DEMAND

Energy supplied hereunder will be delivered through no more than 1 single phase or polyphase meter. Customer’s demand shall be taken monthly to be the highest registration of a 15-minute integrating demand meter or indicator, or the highest registration of a thermal type demand meter.

TERM OF CONTRACT

Annual - self renewing.
